



Georgian Triangle Pickleball Club Member Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all members participating in The Georgian Triangle Pickleball Club ('GTPC') programs, activities and events.

The GTPC values include:

- Good sportsmanship amongst our members by providing a safe and enjoyable atmosphere and consistently demonstrating sport leadership and ethical conduct
- An environment where all persons are treated with respect and dignity, free of discrimination, harassment and profanity

We hold everyone to the following standards:

- **Time Management** – Show up on time.
- **Positive behaviour** – Behave in a manner that promotes the health, safety and wellbeing of themselves and others, using language and actions that are positive, encouraging and supportive
- **Fairplay** – Exhibit fairness and honesty in dealings with others.
- **Exercise due care with all facilities and equipment in use** – Acknowledge GTPC members are guests at various pickleball facilities and will act in accordance with all facility rules and policies, exhibiting good citizenship on behalf of GTPC
- **Cancellations** – A minimum of 24 hours notice is required, should a game need to be cancelled. Repeat offenders will be removed from play for two (2) weeks.¹
- **GTPC representation** – Only GTPC board members or their assigned delegates shall act on behalf of the club and/or negotiate, represent or speak on club matters to partners, stakeholders or the broader external community
- **Get Involved** – Take an active role as an ambassador for the Georgian Triangle Pickleball Club – volunteering as a court host or at club events.
